I have the pleasure to inform you that I accept the no-cost extension of the project "Building Resilience through Innovation and Open Data in Sub-Saharan Africa" (Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery) as requested in your letter of 27 March. Belgium allocated 600.000 EUR to GFDRR to fund innovative projects in four countries in the Africa region.

The three government counterparts – Uganda Bureau of Statistics, Office of the Prime Minister and Kampala Capital City Authority – have requested to extend the timeline for the "On Mapping Project" in Uganda to allow for coordination among these agencies, to align this project with other resilience initiatives ongoing in the country and to ensure ownership and sustainability of the innovations implemented. Therefore, I accept a no-cost extension of the project until September 30, 2018.
