Programme**

Reference is made to the above Delegate Cooperation Agreement (DCA) for the above programme signed by DFID and Belgium (the Donors) on the above mentioned dates. The amendment to DCA outlined below follows the recent discussions between the two Governments about the TMEA Rwanda Programme delayed implementation of outcome 4 – "Improved Efficiency and Capacity of Transport Infrastructure on Lake Kivu".

Now, THEREFORE, the Donors have made the following changes to the Delegated Cooperation Agreement.

Paragraph 2

1. The Belgium contribution will be earmarked to the 'Programme Appraisal Report Cross Border Trade (Borderlands) – Rwanda Country Programme – Outcome 4: – "Improved Efficiency and Capacity of Transport Infrastructure on Lake Kivu" and commence on the date of signature of this Agreement and will end on 30 June 2020. The Contribution will be used for programmes expenditures during this period.
2. This amendment to the DCA will place on record our common understanding of the above change and will come into operation on the date of signing by the Belgian



Embassy and DFID as confirmed below. This note will be known as amendment
