Dear Madam,

Following your communication, dated August 10th 2020, I would like to inform you that I agree to a “No Cost Extension” of 6 months for the project mentioned above. This extension only applies to the part of the project being implemented in Syria. The project is therefore extended to March 10th 2021.

The request is justified by the challenges faced in Syria over the past several months, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which led to delays in implementing child protection and social protection activities as authorities placed risk mitigation measures to contain the spread of the disease.

The no-cost extension does not imply any changes to the scope and targets of the project. Such a modification is foreseen in the “Terms and Conditions of the contribution” under art. 3.5.

This letter constitutes an addendum to the letter-agreement, regulating the execution modalities relating to the aforementioned project.
