- I refer to the Delegate Cooperation Agreement (DCA) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland acting through the Department for International Development ("DFID") and The Kingdom of Belgium signed on 18th July 2018, including subsequent amendments signed on 19th October 2018.
- 2. When the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office ("FCDO") was established on 2 September 2020 the awarding body of the Delegate Cooperation Agreement referenced above automatically transferred from DFID to FCDO. The FCDO therefore proposes to delete all references to "Department for International Development" and "DFID" in the original Delegate Cooperation Agreement and all subsequent amendments, and replace them with "Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office" and "FCDO".
- 3. Following recent correspondence, FCDO proposes to change the end date of the Delegate Cooperation Agreement.
- 4. I propose that the end date of "1st April 2021" in paragraph 2 of the original Delegate Cooperation Agreement be deleted and replaced with "1st April 2022".
- 5. This letter of amendment will place on record our common understanding of the above change(s) and will come into operation on the date you sign your confirmation below. This note will be known as Amendment No. 2/21.
- 6. Please sign both copies of this letter; return one to me and retain the other for your own records.
