Ugandan Deputy Prime minister Moses Ali was the guest of honor and in order to increase visibility towards the Belgian audience, SSU invited Belgian singer DAAN as a special guest.

The event was framed within result area 1 and aimed at discussing the key role of the private sector in modern demand-driven BTVET, qualitative certification and sustainable financing for skills development. Prominent government and private sector actors from Rwanda, Ghana and Namibia gave their views on the way forward for Ugandan skills development. Ugandan first lady and minister of Education Janet Musevenis was the guest of honor.

The minister spoke with women following a training to make soap and also witnessed a short course on hand-pump maintenance. Key topics included how SSU wants to break down skills provision into its smallest possible form by working in the nexus between development cooperation and humanitarian aid. The team demonstrated the voucher scheme to provide qualitative and

flexible 'instant trainings' to answer to training demands of both refugees and host communities.

The « Skills4Jobs » slogan of the Skills Development Fund was established through a participatory process in which the SSU communication team requested students of SSU's partner VTI's to write down their slogan preferences. A questionnaire was conducted in September 2017 amongst 48 priority trade students of the Kasese Polytechnic, St-Joseph Virika, St-Simon and Millenium Business School. This C4D approach allows for more ownership of the slogan by the beneficiaries, as it is depicted on their branded protective wear and sponsored equipment.

9. Knowledge management
