Referring to your letter as GENE Director dd. 28th of September 2021, I am pleased to inform you that the Belgian government, acting through the Directorate General for Development Cooperation (DGD) of the Federal Public Service Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation, responds positively to your request regarding the participant fee for the year 2021 for the Stichting Global Education Network Europe, hereinafter referred to as GENE.

To this end the Belgian government will assign a grant of maximum 45.000 EUR as participant fee to GENE for the year 2021. This amount shall be used to finance the activities and the categories of expenditure, as projected in the attachment, 'GENE Work Programme 2021'.
