

FOURTH ADDENDUM
To
The AGREEMENT
Signed between
THE KINGDOM OF BELGIUM
and


The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
Regarding Contribution to TradeMark East Africa Strategy II: Burundi Country
Programme

1. I refer to the Delegated Cooperation Agreement (DCA) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland acting through the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office ("FCDO") and The Kingdom of Belgium signed on 18th July 2018, including subsequent amendments signed on 19th October 2018 and 13th April 2022.
2. The Amendment to the DCA outlined below follows recent discussions to have a new bank account opened to have the last tranche of the Belgium contribution to Burundi programme
3. I propose to delete the text within paragraphs 4 and 5 of the original DCA and replace with:
4. "FCDO will request payments using Annex 1 and provide the Kingdom of Belgium with supporting documentation. We request that the Kingdom of Belgium deposit the Third Payment of up to **€500,000 (Five Hundred Thousand Euros)** into the following **GBP** bank account, the details of which are set out below.
