Addendum No. 1 to the Standard Administrative Arrangement

between

the Government of Belgium

and

The United Nations Development Programme regarding the contribution to The Central Africa Forest Initiative (CAFI)

The Government of Belgium (hereafter referred to as the "Donor"), and the United Nations Development Programme Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office (hereinafter referred to as "UNDP") acting as Administrative Agent of CAFI on behalf of itself and all the Participating UN Organizations, (hereinafter referred to as the "Administrative Agent") have agreed as follows:

WHEREAS, Participating United Nations Organizations that have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Participating UN Organizations") have established CAFI Multi- Partner Trust Fund (hereinafter referred to as the "Fund") starting on 7 September 2015 and ending on 31 December 2027 as may be amended from time to time, as more fully described in the Terms of Reference of the Fund (hereinafter referred to as the "TOR"), a copy of which is attached hereto as ANNEX A; and

WHEREAS, Participating UN Organizations has established an Executive Board of Directors to provide the oversight and strategic direction of the Fund and a Secretariat to manage daily the operation of the Fund, as fully described in the TOR.

WHEREAS in Section 1, paragraph 1 of the Standard Administrative Arrangement signed between the Donor and the Administrative Agent (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Participants") on 15 October 2021, the Donor contributed Three Million EUR (3,000,000 EUR),

The Donor has now agreed to make a further contribution to the Fund.

The Standard Administrative Arrangement between the Participants is therefore modified as follows:

Article I Additional Contribution

The Donor agrees to make an additional contribution of **Three Million EUR** (3,000,000 EUR) to be used for the purposes of the Fund in accordance with the Standard Administrative Arrangement. This contribution is earmarked for the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The Donor will deposit the contribution by wire transfer, in accordance with the schedule of payments set out in ANNEX B to this Addendum and in convertible currencies of unrestricted use to the following account:

The donors agree to and accept any consequences and risks related to the selection of the NUNOs, transfer of funds and other activities undertaken by the AA under the instruction of the Fund's Executive Board, and activities of the NUNO.

Article III Remaining conditions of the Standard Administrative Arrangement

All other terms and conditions of the Standard Administrative Arrangement remain unchanged. This Addendum will come into effect on the date of signature by the Participants.
